SURVEY - Communion, Participation, and Mission Transforming Our Lives; Building Our Church

Pope Francis has announced that in preparation for the next Synod of Bishops, there will be a worldwide conversation in the Church or a "synod" about community, engaged participation, and the mission of evangelization. This conversation will follow a two-year path and involve the People of God - everyone, everywhere.

This Sunday at 10:30 a.m., +Most Reverend Bishop Miehm will celebrate a Mass at the Cathedral of St. Peter-in-Chains to launch the synod and the diocesan pastoral planning process locally. This celebration roots the synod in prayer, sacrament, and community. This Mass will also be live-streamed through the YouTube link below.
