Pre-Authorized Giving- PAG

(Vacation, sickness, bad weather, worldwide pandemic). By signing up for PAG, you make a clear statement of what is important to you. You also give the parish the peace of mind that comes with knowing your help is stable and reliable. It's really easy.

Advantages for you:

- Convenience: Your offering is deducted from your account twice a month and automatically deposited into the Parish account.
- You can plan your giving in advance for the whole year
- You can continue to support St. Mary's when you are away, sick, stuck at home because of weather or a world-wide pandemic.
- No Charges or fees to you

How will PAG replace my current giving?

If you participate in the Pre-Authorized Giving plan, you will not need to use envelopes for your regular weekly donations.

Because the PAG does not include certain special collections such as the monthly Building Maintenance offering, you can contribute by using a plain envelope and writing your name on the envelope.
