

What are the Benefits of Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG)?

How will PAG replace my current giving?

If you participate in the Pre-Authorized Giving plan, you will not need to use envelopes for your regular weekly donations. Because the PAG does not include certain special collections such as the monthly Building Maintenance offering, you can contribute by using a plain envelope and writing your name on the envelope. E-Transfers - The Parish is able to accept e-transfers.
