OUR ACTION THIS FALL: Share Lent was a time to not only raise funds. It was also a time to learn about the program in year one of our 5 year 'Create Hope' theme: **Stand for the Land**. During Lent we learned about the important issue of land; the fall is coming and it is time to **Stand for the Land** by taking action.

Our action will be focused on expressing our Solidarity with the Guapinol community in Honduras. This community, which is accompanied by our Honduran Partner, Fundacion ERIC, has been criminalized for defending their territory against a mining company (not a Canadian company for once!). Three members of the community have been assassinated, one as recently as June 15th!

Our action will be to collect signatures to petition the Honduran Ambassador to Canada to call on the Honduran government to bring justice for this community. This action has a chance of success as a progressive government was recently elected in Honduras; it may be open to listening to international pressure.

You are invited to join us for a **national webinar to kick off our fall action** on **Saturday September 16th, 2023 at 1:30pm.** We hope to have someone from our partner Fundacion ERIC present, as well as a member from the Guapinol community. More information will come closer to the date.
