REMINDER FROM DIOCESAN FINANCE OFFICE - I am thankful to the Chancery for keeping an eye to our parish financial conditions. Deb McCrae, the Diocesan Director of Finance, Property & Administration told us that the Parish RBC balance as of July 4th was \$5,600. She is hoping that once I am settled in, I can have discussions with the finance council to determine what has already been tried to increase offertory and what the next steps might be to revitalize the parish community and its finances. I also appreciate the Parish Financial Council through Melissa for keeping me updated weekly of our bank balance. With our concerted efforts and the concerned assistance of our relatives and friends outside, it is my hope that we can do something to find ways to raise our relatively low income and enable our parish to run its normal operation.
