FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

<u>PARISH COUNCIL MEETING</u> - I am looking forward to the Parish Council meeting tomorrow, Monday the 11th. Please pray for the success of the said meeting as important things in the agenda are to be discussed and need to be realized.

<u>FR IVAN DYER</u> - Thanking Fr. Ivan Dyer for his generous gesture of giving his time to celebrate the 5pm weekend Mass with us. Next Saturday, Fr. Emmanuel of St. Michael, Cobourg is going to celebrate the 5pm Mass.

REVERENCE TO THE ALTAR AND TABERNACLE - "The general norm is that the priest and the other ministers genuflect to the tabernacle when they approach the altar and when they depart from it, but not during the celebration of Mass itself. Exempted to genuflect is the deacon with book of the gospels and altar servers carrying cross, candles, etc. They just bow instead. The altar symbolizes Christ and becomes the focus during holy Mass." When we enter the Church, we always look for the Tabernacle to give our worship to the Blessed Sacrament by genuflecting or kneeling. But if the Mass gets started and going, the focus now is on the altar. Readers and Extraordinary Ministers, in particular, who do some movements during Mass have to take note, that coming up to the ambo to read, they don't have to genuflect to the tabernacle. The same with EM, who, coming up to the sanctuary to receive the ciborium and distribute communion, don't have to genuflect to the tabernacle. They may bow to the altar. I thank one of our Readers who brought to my attention this clarifications.

<u>EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS</u>— I have pouches for our extraordinary ministers to use for their PYX when they bring Communion to shut-ins. If you already have one, you may save it as reserve. Along with this pouch is a glass candle to be lit during the short Communion rite with the shut-in. You may get the said pouch from me after the Mass.
