As such, he neither needs to be represented with the image of the divine mercy (presently on top of the tabernacle), nor be represented by the statue of the sacred heart (presently beside the tabernacle) because Jesus who himself is the divine mercy and the sacred heart is present real and actual in the Blessed Sacrament inside the Tabernacle. Statues & images of Jesus surrounding close to the tabernacle, sacred as they are, could take away our attention to the real presence of Christ when we come to adore our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. With these explanations plus instructions from the office of the bishop, soon we will move the statue of the sacred heart and the image of the divine mercy away from the tabernacle, or the tabernacle itself will be relocated to the center of the sanctuary behind the altar, beneath the crucifix. All of the relocations of the things mentioned will be done according to the liturgical norms and approval from the bishop's office. I thank you all for your kind understanding.
