household groups which meet frequently for mutual support in living the Christian life. With this letter, I wish to assure you that Couples for Christ has my approval to operate in the Diocese of Peterborough. Among other things, their goals align very well many of the priorities in our Diocesan Pastoral Plan. You may feel confident in discussing with them possible ventures within your parish."

#### **DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE**

This fall, we're continuing Caritas Canada's *Create Hope: Stand for the Land* campaign. This time, we'll be meeting communities in northern Honduras who have been struggling to preserve their land and water since an iron ore mine opened in Carlos Escaleras National Park, and poisoned the rivers on which they depend for their livelihoods. Our partner ERIC—Radio Progreso has asked that we support the defenders of human rights and the environment in Honduras. Since 2015, the communities of Guapinol and the San Pedro sector have been fighting to preserve their rivers and the Carlos Escaleras National Park from mining. In their struggle for justice, defenders are attacked, criminalized and even killed. Eight defenders were unjustly imprisoned for over two years, and three people have been murdered since January 2023. "Communities are displaced. Rights are violated. Access and rights to water denied. All this to give priority to the extraction and pillaging of resources.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

SPECIAL COLLECTION - Today, November 18th & 19th, a special collection towards Indigenous Reconciliation Fund (IRF) will be taken up in our diocese. Envelopes for that purpose are available at the church entrance. This is our third collection to support the pledge of the Canadian Bishops to raise 30 million dollars to promote projects that advance the cause of reconciliation and address the trauma caused by residential schools. Thank you for your generosity in the past two collections! Our Diocesan IRF committee, composed of Indigenous representatives, has met several times in recent months. They recently recommended eight projects totaling \$160,000.00 for approval by the National IRF Board of Directors, which oversees the local campaigns. The applicants are from various First Nations and Métis groups in Kawartha, Muskoka and Parry Sound regions, and their projects are all very worthy ones – your kind donations are making this possible.

WORLD DAY OF THE POOR - Today is World Day of the Poor, an annual event celebrated on the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Pope Francis instituted it in 2017 so that throughout the world Christian communities can become an ever greater sign of Christ's charity for the least and those most in need. The theme for World Day of the Poor 2023 is a passage from the Book of Tobit: "Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor." "'A great river of poverty is traversing our cities', and that every Christian is called to become 'personally involved' in the struggle against it. When we encounter a poor person, we cannot look away, for that would prevent us from encountering the face of the Lord Jesus," Pope Francis wrote.
