Moreover, you have indicated that the proposed move of the tabernacle to the current place of the presider's chair should not involve any construction or financial costs to the parish. Accordingly, I accede to your request and grant you permission to relocate the tabernacle Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary church from its current location to the center of the sanctuary. I pray that this rearrangement may prove to be of spiritual benefit to the worshipping community and promote greater reverence and devotion to the Eucharist. FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

<u>ADVENT SECOND SUNDAY</u> - Today is the second Sunday of Advent, and the theme for this week is waiting with patience. The second Sunday in Advent continues on the path started in the first week by looking forward to Christ's first and second coming. Advent II focuses on John the Baptist, the Gentiles being included in God's family, Christ's coming in judgment and peace, and the church's hopeful expectation of the completion of his promises.



LITURGICAL SENSE (what & how to venerate during Mass)— The General Instruction on the Roman Missal (GIRM), which outlines liturgical instructions for the Mass liturgy, states that genuflections to the tabernacle ought not to take place during Mass. Why? The presence of the tabernacle, (while still sacred and important) is not our primary focus. Our primary focus is instead placed on the sacred altar (e.g., upon which the Eucharistic sacrifice occurs right before us). It is therefore, to the altar that we bow during the Mass. Let us state simply that during Mass the Church desires that all attention be focused on the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice. It is no disrespect toward Christ in the tabernacle when his altar is venerated during Mass.
