NICENE CREED & APOSTLES' CREED - The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) allows the use of either the Nicene Creed or the Apostles' Creed. Ultimately, the choice of which one to use is up to the discretion of the presiding priest. The Roman Missal offers the celebrant a little guidance: "Traditionally, the Apostles' Creed is used during the season of Lent, Easter Sunday and the season of 'Ordinary Time'. Nicene Creed is traditionally used at all feast days and during the celebratory seasons of Advent, Christmas, and Easter".

CANDLE MASS (Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, February 2) It is a traditional weather prediction rhyme that has been passed down through generations. According to the rhyme, "If Candlemas day be sunny and bright, winter again will show its might. If Candlemas day be cloudy and grey, winter soon will pass away. If Candlemas day be fair and bright, winter will have another flight. If Candlemas day be shower and rain, winter is gone and will not come again. "However, it is important to note that the weather on Candlemas day does not necessarily predict the weather for the rest of the winter season. The weather is influenced by many factors and can be unpredictable.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK - February 11 (the feast of our Lady of Lourdes) was declared The World Day of the Sick. The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. The observance of this Day recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to help restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease. In observance of the World Day of the Sick, a "Pray over & Holy Anointing" will be administered to those who feel the need for either physical or spiritual healings after both the 4pm and 10am Masses this coming weekend.

<u>POPE'S PRAYER INTENTION FOR FEBRUARY</u> (For The Terminally ILL) - "Let us pray that the sick who are in the final stages of life, and their families, receive the necessary medical and human care and accompaniment."

"LET YOUR SPEECH ALWAYS BE GRACIOUS" is a pastoral letter released by the Canadian Bishops this week on the use of Social Media. While recognizing the great potential for good in social media, it also points out how it "can play on the worst of our human tendencies, leading to online environments that violate the core Christian values of truth and human dignity." The bishops go on to recommend seven commitments we can make together to build healthy online environments that serve the common good. In a world that is more and more influenced by social media, this brief letter with its practical advice is well worth a read.

POPE FRANCIS HAS SET THE STAGE FOR A NEW CANADIAN SAINT. Earlier this week Pope Francis signed a decree recognizing a miracle attributed to Blessed Marie-Leonie Paradis, who founded the Little Sisters of the Holy Family. She died in Sherbrooke, Quebec in 1912 and was beatified by St. Pope John Paul II on his visit to Canada in 1984. Sister Marie-Leonie felt called to found a new religious order with the specific task of helping the priests and seminarians, dedicated to service, which would be home-grown Canadian. Today her sisters work in over 200 institutions of education and evangelization in Canada, the United States, Italy, Brazil, Haiti, Chile, Honduras, and Guatemala.
