FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK - Today, February 11, the feast of our Lady of Lourdes is declared "The World Day of the Sick." The Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous 18 times in 1858 in Lourdes, France. Since then, millions of pilgrims have travelled to Lourdes to gather and pray where the apparitions took place. Pilgrims come from all religions and nationalities to ask for healing, peace, reconciliation and faith. The

ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. In commemoration of the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and in observance of the World Day of the Sick, "Pray over & Holy Anointing" will be administered to those who feel the need for either physical or spiritual healings after both the 4pm and 10am Masses.

ASH WEDNESDAY - Ash Wednesday this year is on the 14th of February. Our Ash Wednesday Mass and the giving of ash will be @ 9am. Ashes hold a deep symbolic meaning, a reminder of our mortality and the temporary nature of life on earth. They symbolize humility, reminding us that we are made from dust and to dust we shall return. Ash Wednesday starts the season of Lent by focusing the Christian's heart on repentance and prayer and by engaging in fasting and self-denial as a way of drawing closer to God.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS - Starting this coming Friday and all Fridays within the season of Lent, all are invited to join the Station of the Cross after the 9am Mass. The objective of the stations of the cross is to help the Christian faithful to make a spiritual pilgrimage through contemplation of the Passion of Christ. Stations of the Cross is a means of sharing Christ's suffering. We are not mere spectators; we walk alongside Him. We learn that our struggles, failures, and moments of weakness can be united with Christ's redemptive work. Our crosses—

whether small or significant—can be transformed into opportunities for grace. Despite the darkness of Good Friday, the Stations point us toward Easter Sunday. Only in Christ crucified and risen can we find salvation and redemption.
