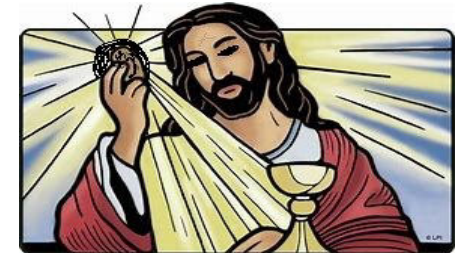

FROM THE PASTOR’S DESK

CEMETERY MASS - Please take note that this coming Saturday, August 17, the Mass will be celebrated in the Cemetery at 10 am in remembrance of our loved ones who have gone before us. There will be no regular 9 am Mass in the church but the regular weekly Confession schedule will be attended at the usual 8:30 am.

PARISH PATRONAL FEAST DAY CELEBRATION - Next Sunday, August 18th @ 10 am Mass, we are going to celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Mary after whom our parish is named and has been under her patronage. It’s a special occasion for our community to come together and celebrate our spiritual heritage by giving our Blessed Mother special honor for all the intercessions she bestowed on all parishioners through the years. Everyone is invited for the BBQ right after the Mass.

CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY - The Seventh corporal works of mercy is “TO GIVE ALMS TO THE POOR”- Catechism of the Catholic Church #2447: “The corporal works of mercy consist especially in feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and imprisoned, and burying the dead. Among all these, giving alms to the poor is one of the chief witnesses to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God: He who has two coats, let him share with him who has none and he who has food must do likewise. But give for alms those things which are within; and behold, everything is clean for you. If a brother or sister is ill-clad and in lack of daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what does it profit?"
